NEP - 2020 Post Graduate Entrance Examinations - 2023-24

Being an Autonomous College, syllabus was framed according to NEP – 2020 for all PG programs as per the Government of Maharashtra GR एनईपी-2022/प्र.क्र.09/विशी-3 शिकाना dt. 16/05/2023.

Students desirous to take admission for M.Sc./M.A. Part-I at MES Abasaheb Garware College (Autonomous), Pune, both from Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) and other universities must appear for the Online Entrance Examination (OEE). However, appearing for Entrance Examination does not confirm the admission.

Candidates will be admitted to the below mentioned courses strictly on the basis of the merit of OEE and as per the reservation norms of Government of Maharashtra and Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

OEE will be of 100 marks with multiple choice questions (MCQ) of equal weightage.

Syllabus of OEE for each course is mentioned in front of the subject.

Negative marking system will be applied for evaluation. For every wrong answer one half (1/2) of the allotted marks of the question will be deducted.

Merit list for the admission will be based on the total score obtained in OEE. In case candidates securing equal marks in OEE, same number will be given to all candidates in merit list and during table admission their CGPA / percentage of marks will be considered for SEM III to V of appeared candidates and SEM III to VI for candidates whose results are already declared.

Candidates who are appearing the final year qualifying examination of the course are allowed to apply for OEE. However, admission of such candidate is subject to their passing the qualifying examination.

Merit list of each course will be published on college website within five days after the examination.

Processing fee: Rs. 500/- (Including 18% GST) for OPEN category

Rs. 400/- (Including 18% GST) for Reserved category

Candidates please note that bank charges are extra than the above charges and they will vary as per the selection of payment gateway.

Rules for the admission: Admission will be given as per the reservation rules and regulations of Savitribai Phule Pune University and Government of Maharashtra.

College has been granted Autonomy by UGC and SPPU; syllabus for all the courses is designed by the college, as per the norms of UGC and SPPU.

Filling of Merit form does not secure the admission to the course.

There are limited seats for each course.

Some of the courses are run on non-grant basis.

The college reserves the rights to make any necessary changes in the schedule and admission procedure, if required.

Important Instructions regarding Proctor Examination

- Candidates can appear for this exam from any location. 1.
- Candidate can appear the examination using laptop / desktop / mobile phone with camera 2. and a good internet connectivity.
- Minimum System Requirements to appear for the exam 3.
 - -- Latest version of Google Chrome Browser
 - -- Web Cam in working condition
 - -- Internet Speed at least 1 Mbps or more
- The web camera of your system must be enabled and must remain switched on throughout the examination. In the event of non-receipt of webcam, your examination will be 4. considered as null and void.
- Do not use alt-tab, mouse or any other device to shift from examination screen to any other screen or do not try to open any other application while attempting the 5. examination. Doing so may result in discontinuation of examination and your examination will be considered as null and void.
- Resume Exam: If your computer gets hang or your power supply goes off during exam you need to re-logging with your login credentials, all attempted questions will be saved in the database and you can resume the same exam. In this scenario, you will not get any additional time.
- The clock has been set at the server and the countdown timer at the top right corner of your screen will display the time remaining for you to complete the examination. When 7. the clock runs out, the examination ends by default - you are not required to end or submit your examination at that time.
- The "Marked for Review" status simply acts as a reminder that you have set to look at the question again. If an answer is selected for a question that is "Marked for Review", 8. the answer will be considered in the final evaluation.
- To change an answer to a question, first select the question and then click on the new answer option followed by a click on the "Next Question" button.
- 10. You can give an answer of review questions by referring the "Review Questions" section present at the right side on the screen.
- 11. Questions that are saved or marked for review after answering will ONLY be considered Garwa for evaluation.
- 12. Click on "Finish Examination" button to end / submit the examination.

13. Candidate should note that Proctor can also pause or terminate the exam if found any unfair activity by the student during the exams.
